You will work directly with the Operations and Purchasing Manager, internal organizations and external Freight Forwarders and Customs brokers to facilitate regional import/export processes, programs and related requirements are in compliance.

Role and Responsibilities

- Accountable for determining the most efficient and cost-effective methods of shipping without compromising quality.
- Supervise the administrative process, schedule, and shipment of all commodities internationally/domestically.
- Interface with international and domestic retail partners, foreign subsidiaries, vendors, brokers, and carriers to ensure compliance with all applicable import/export regulations.
- Collect and maintain database of tariff codes, international order log, and international tracking sheet.
- Work with carriers/brokers to clear international shipments by assisting with HTS codes and any other missing documentation.
- Assist in finding new carriers for AIR/Ocean and even domestic shipments for cost savings while streamlining shipment strategies to achieve goal.
- Develop International/Domestic routing guides for internal/external parties.
- Monitor, record, analyze and report on activities, trends, results and recommendations related to import/export activities specifically related to duties and China Section 301 Tariff.
- Interacting with suppliers, cross functional in-house teams and multiple plants including overseas.
- Develops and implements process improvement strategies within the department.
- Assist purchasing in making decisions on how to ship material when ready by reviewing stock lists available from overseas plants in reviewing demand and weights of material to make most economic decisions on shipment methods.
- Develop and maintain component weights in ERP system from international suppliers.
- Special projects as assigned.

- Previous Import/Export experience within an industrial manufacturing environment with commodities such as wire, cable, electrical connectors, and components...is a PLUS
- Global experience with knowledge of importing/exporting products to and from the USA
- Experience with US customs regulations and managing relationships with brokers and carriers
- Knowledge and ability to create import/export documents
- Working knowledge of US Customs laws, Incoterms, Harmonized Tariff Classifications, understanding of the GRI's, Section and Chapter notes and explanatory notes
